A Century of Shoreside History

Algonquin Shores is more than just a getaway; it is a piece of Oxtongue Lake history that spans over a century.

The Pioneer Roots: The land you are standing on was originally settled by **Charles Nunn**, who purchased it directly from the Crown in 1907 for just \$1.00 an acre. Nunn was a pioneer in the truest sense—an avid fisherman and woodsman who helped build the foundations of the Oxtongue Village community.

In 1915, a man named James Rennie built a dovetailed log cabin on this shore—one of the last of its kind. From early weddings held on the property in the 1920s to its time as part of a local mill, this land has always been a place where people gathered to enjoy the rugged beauty of the Muskoka-Algonquin Highlands.

Our Founding Season: After over 100 years of history, **you are joining us for our founding season.** This is our very first year of operation as Algonquin Shores. Our mission is to preserve the rustic, "pioneer" charm that Charles Nunn first fell in love with, while ensuring you have all the modern comforts you need for a perfect escape.

What to Bring & What we Provide

To help you pack light, here is a breakdown of what you'll find at the cottage and what we recommend bringing along.

We Provide:

- **Kitchen:** Fridge, stove (oven does not function), dishwasher (+tablets), (countertop) toaster oven, toaster, and **Keurig coffee maker** (+limited pods).
- **Cooking Basics:** 5-piece cookware set, salt, black pepper, and olive oil.
- **BBQ:** Propane BBQ with propane supplied.
- **Water Dispenser:** Please note that **tap water is non-potable**. We provide a water dispenser with ONE 15L jug of fresh drinking water.
- **Comfort:** All bed linens, bath towels, and sample toiletry kits.

What You Should Bring:

- **Water Bottles & Drinks:** While we provide a 15L water dispenser, feel free to bring reusable water bottles for hiking and any extra preferred beverages.
- **Coffee Pods:** We provide a few pods to get you started, but if you are a heavy coffee drinker, please bring your own **K-Cups**.
- **Firewood:** If you plan on enjoying the fire pit, please bring your own firewood (available at the Dwight Market nearby).
- **Beach Towels:** Please bring your own towels for the beach or lake.
- **Bug Spray & Sunscreen:** Essential for enjoying the outdoors comfortably.
- **Groceries & Specialty Spices:** Stop in Huntsville on your way for a full shop, or use the Dwight Market for essentials.

Directions: Take Hwy 400 North to Hwy 11 North. Exit at Hwy 60 East toward Dwight/Algonquin Park. Follow Hwy 60 for about 20 minutes. Look for the Algonquin Shores sign on the lakeside of Highway 60.



As you get closer, keep an eye out for the mailing number plate “**4014**” near the driveway entrance. You’ll also partially see the Algonquin Shores sign nearby, confirming you’re in the right place.

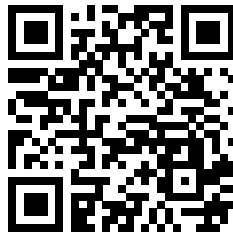

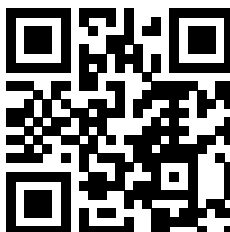

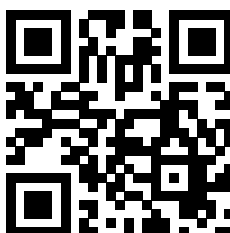
