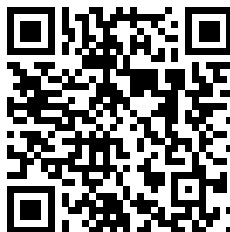
Our goal is a smooth, comfortable stay from start to finish: clear arrival instructions, a clean apartment, and fresh linens and towels ready for you.

TV & Streaming

TV Quick Start

1. Turn on the TV (TV remote).
2. Press **Input/Source** and select the **HDMI** connected to the BetterSTR box.
3. Use the **BetterSTR/Android remote** to browse the guidebook and streaming apps.

TV & Streaming (Details + Troubleshooting)

What's installed

This apartment has a TV plus a **BetterSTR TV box** connected via **HDMI**. The BetterSTR box provides the guest home screen, guidebook, Wi-Fi QR, and streaming/casting features.

Turn it on (2 remotes)

- **TV remote:** power + HDMI input/source
- **BetterSTR/Android remote:** navigation, apps, guidebook

If you don't see the BetterSTR screen

- Press **Input / Source** on the TV remote

- Select the correct **HDMI** (often HDMI 1 or HDMI 2)

Streaming apps

You can use streaming apps from the BetterSTR home screen (depending on setup).

- Please use **your own accounts**
- Please **log out before check?out** for privacy

Casting from your phone/laptop

- Connect your device to the **same Wi-Fi** as the TV
- Use the app's **Cast / AirPlay** button and select the TV device

About the Area

{{property_name}} is located on Aleje Jerozolimskie — one of Warsaw's main central avenues — which makes it an excellent base for both sightseeing and business trips. You're in a very well-connected part of the city with quick access to trains, trams, buses, and key city landmarks, so you can spend your time enjoying Warsaw instead of planning logistics.

What it feels like

This is a lively, urban neighbourhood: central, practical, and walkable, with plenty of cafés, bakeries, casual restaurants, and everyday services nearby. Because it's a major avenue, you'll notice typical city activity (traffic and people) during the day — in return you get convenience and fast connections across Warsaw.

Getting around from here

One of the biggest advantages of this location is how easy it is to move around the city:

- **Warsaw West Station area** is close, making airport transfers and day trips straightforward.
- Multiple **tram and bus lines** run along/near Aleje Jerozolimskie, connecting you quickly to *śródmieście* and beyond.
- Many top areas are reachable by a short ride (or a longer walk if you enjoy exploring on foot).

Food, coffee & essentials

You'll find everything you need within a short distance:

- Grocery stores and convenience shops for quick supplies
- Pharmacies and basic services (ATMs, small shops)
- Coffee spots and casual dining options for breakfast or a late snack

Why guests like it

Guests usually choose this area because it's:

- **Central** (easy to reach from almost anywhere)
- **Time-saving** (simple transfers, less commuting)
- **Flexible** (good for short stays, longer holidays, and work trips)

Shopping & Essentials

You're in a very convenient spot for everyday essentials around **Aleje Jerozolimskie 135**, close to **Warsaw West (Warszawa Zachodnia)**. This area is practical and well connected, so it's easy to pick up groceries or last-minute items without spending time crossing the city.

Within a short walk you'll find **supermarkets and convenience stores** for breakfast supplies, snacks, bottled water, and simple meals, plus **pharmacies, ATMs**, and other useful services. It's a good setup whether you're arriving late, staying for a weekend, or settling in for a longer trip.

For **business travelers**, it's easy to grab coffee, a quick lunch, and essentials before meetings, and the transport links from Warszawa Zachodnia make moving around Warsaw efficient. For **tourists**, it's ideal for stocking up before sightseeing days and for picking up anything you forgot to pack.

Getting Around

[Public Transport](#)

Buses, Metro & Trams

Warsaw has an excellent public transport network including metro lines, trams, and buses. The Aleje Jerozolimskie corridor is very well served, giving you fast access to the city centre and beyond.

Tickets can be purchased at machines at metro stations, from drivers on some services, or via the Warsaw public transport app. Your host can advise on the nearest stops.

Taxis & Rideshare

Ride-hailing apps are widely available and reliable in Warsaw. They're a convenient option for late-night travel or when you're carrying luggage. Your host can recommend trusted local options.

Cycling

Warsaw has a growing network of cycle lanes and a city bike-share scheme (Veturilo). It's a great way to explore the city at your own pace. Docking stations can be found throughout the central districts.
