### ?? Hot Tub Guidelines – Soak Safely & Relax ??

To make sure everyone enjoys the hot tub safely and the equipment stays in top shape, please follow these simple guidelines:

#### ? Shower First

Rinse off before entering to keep the water clean and protect the tub's filters.

#### ? Max Occupancy

Only 6 guests at a time. Overcrowding can reduce comfort and strain the system.

#### ? Chemical Additive

Inside the steps, you'll find **Spa Protector by Pool Day**. Add one full scoop a few minutes before use to keep the water fresh for you and future guests.

? Rubber Duck Alert: The floating duck contains the chemicals—please leave it in the tub at all times.

### ?? Temperature Limit

The tub is preset to **98** °F. You can raise it up to **104** °F before use—give the tub a few hours to reach your desired temperature. Before leaving, **return it to 98** °F and make sure the cover is fully on.

#### ? No Glass, Food, or Drinks in Tub

Use only plastic or non-breakable containers. Broken glass or food can damage the water chemistry. Draining the tub due to contamination may incur **\$500+ fees**.

### ? No Alcohol or Drugs While Soaking

For your safety, please avoid using the tub under the influence.

### ? Children Must Be Supervised

Anyone under 16 must have an adult present while in or around the tub.

### ? No Open Wounds or Illness

Skip soaking if you have cuts, abrasions, or feel unwell.

### ? No Pets or Diving

Pets and jumping/diving are strictly prohibited.

#### ? Cover When Not in Use

Always replace the cover to retain heat and keep debris out. Leaving it off may result in **excessive heat loss charges**.

#### ? Quiet Hours

Hot tub use is limited between 11:00 PM - 7:00 AM to respect our neighbors.

### ?? Use at Your Own Risk

Guests are responsible for safe use. Hosts are not liable for accidents or injuries.

#### ? Damage & Cleaning Fees

Any misuse or extreme cleaning needs may result in \$500+ charges.

#### ? Camera Notice

There is a **camera in the lower hot tub area**. This is only used to ensure rules are followed. Ignore it, follow the rules above, and enjoy the tub and the view!


Unclip the buckles on the front of the hot tub.

Gently lift the cover using the **handle strap**—sometimes a few light pulls work best since the cover can suction to the tub.

Fold the cover in half.

Carefully lift and move it to the **designated spot** shown in the photo/video.

? **Do not drag the cover on the ground.** If you need help, please ask a second person—any damage to the cover may result in charges.



Adjust the **front corners** so the cover sits evenly over the tub.

Reattach the straps to secure the cover.
