
Parking



Thermostat

Thermostat (continued)

The Thermostat is located on the wall to the left of the kitchen. Our home is equipped with central heating and an A/C unit. During extreme hot weather (over 85F) the A/C must not be set lower than 68F or it will not cool the house properly. Please keep doors and windows closed at all times. Any service calls as a result of overworking the A/C, and therefore failure, will require a fee as determined by the service provider.



For your convenience during wildfire or pollen season, there is a free-standing, electric air purifier in the hall closet across from the kitchen. Instructions are included. (Please place it on a hard surface, not carpet).

Garbage/Recycle

Garbage/Recycling Pick up is Tuesday and Friday mornings. Make sure to have your waste out in the cans by 7am on these days. Do not take bins to the road (they pick up from the enclosure only). Overflowing garbage or recycle will be charged \$65/can. Garbage attracts pests. Help keep Sunriver safe and clean by keeping the lids on the bins. Thank you.

Getting Here

Directions to High Desert Escape (20 Whistler Lane):

From the Redmond Airport – Drive time 45 minutes

From the Portland Airport – Drive time 3.5 hours

From Salem – Drive time 3 hours

From Eugene – Drive time 2.5 hours

From Seattle – Drive time 6.5 hours

From Hwy 97, turn onto Cottonwood Rd/Exit 151. Continue 2 miles into 25mph zone

Take the first left after the bridge over the railroad tracks at South Imnaha Rd.

At stop sign, turn left onto Whistler Lane.

At the cul de sac, 20 Whistler will be the second house on the right.





House Rules

House Rules

We kindly ask you to read ALL of our House Rules carefully-keep them top of mind during your stay. Sunriver is a Homeowner's Association. The community has many rules to protect the safety and enjoyment of all residents and visitors. We have our own Police and Fire service districts. Failure to abide by the rules can result in penalty, eviction or both. We appreciate your cooperation and participation in keeping Sunriver a great place to live and visit!

No Parties

- This property has a strict **no parties, events or loud music** policy. Please respect the noise curfew (10 pm-7 am). Please be mindful and keep gatherings small and respectful. Please note: Our home resides in a noise-sensitive area and we participate in our Good Neighbor protection program. Our smart home technology will alert us if excessive decibel or occupancy levels are detected. This technology is privacy compliant, and only monitors the presence of decibels and devices -not any personal conversation or information. We have exterior and garage security cameras. Thank you for supporting our efforts to be good neighbors!

No Smoking/outdoor fires

- No smoking/vaping (in/outdoors), or outdoor fires allowed on the property. (No fire pits or open flame fires allowed). Violate & forfeit \$500 Security Deposit plus possible fines/eviction. No exceptions!

No Fireworks

- ALL fireworks, including safe & sane, are PROHIBITED in Sunriver. HOA violation fines for any of the above are \$2500 per incident!!! If fireworks of any kind are indicated or reported on our property, you will also forfeit your \$500.00 Security Deposit & be evicted. No Exceptions!

No Pets

- Sorry, we cannot allow pets. No exceptions. Violation of this rule will forfeit \$300.00 from the \$500.00 Security Deposit for deep cleaning.

Registered Guests Only

- Primary Renter MUST be present for the duration of the reservation and be age 25 or older. Only the number of guests included in your booking are permitted on the property (this includes babysitters). Extra guests, tents, or campervans are not allowed. If additional guests are found to have stayed without prior approval, you will be charged for their stay along with a \$200 recovery fee. Primary renter must have at least 3 Reviews on

rental platforms with an average of 4.8 or higher. Maximum number of adults (over age 12) is **6**. Occupants age 18 yrs or younger **MUST** be supervised at all times. This property requires a Rental Agreement within 48 HRS of booking, and a \$500.00 security deposit. The Security Deposit will be placed as a hold separately by the property 2 days prior to Check-in.

Parking

- Park in the driveway or garage only. Sunriver HOA has strict parking rules. Fines could be imposed. Parking is not allowed along roadways, in yards or in common areas. For overflow parking, use the parking lot at the north Marketplace grocery store off Cottonwood Rd (back lot). Open the garage door from the control button inside the garage (end of hallway, left from front door). For security, always close the garage when not in use.

No trailers allowed (recreational or utility)

- Our HOA does not allow trailers of any kind on individual property. If you need short term trailer storage while you are visiting, please contact Sunriver Administration and Resources directly at (541) 593-2483.

Take care of our home as if it were your own

- Please take care of the furnishings. You will be charged for damages/replacement. Do not rearrange the furniture. We pass on the \$65/room charge to put furniture back to original location. Please do not eat or drink in the bedrooms. **No glass** allowed at the hot tub (plastic is provided).

Our Indoor Fireplace

- Complimentary firewood-please limit your use to 6 pieces/day. Excess will be billed at current replacement rate. Extra can be purchased at Sunriver Marketplace on Cottonwood Rd. **Please do not have a fire on the morning of your departure. It is dangerous to leave a burning fire in an unoccupied home.**

No hammocks

- Please do not hang hammocks from our trees. It is against HOA design rules, is damaging to the trees, AND is a \$250 fine. Thanks!

Garbage/Recycling

- Pick up is Tuesday and Friday mornings. Make sure to have your waste out in the cans by 7am on these days. Do not take bins to the road (they pick up from the enclosure only). Overflowing garbage or recycle will be charged \$65/can. Garbage attracts pests. Help keep Sunriver safe and clean by keeping the lids on the bins. Thank you.

No Illegal Activity or Substances Allowed

- No illegal substances/activity allowed on the premises. You will be cited/fined and evicted without refund for any unlawful activity.

Respect authorized Check-in/Check-out times and instructions

- Please leave the property in the condition the way you found it. Clean up all spills, wipe down all surfaces, pick up litter. You will be billed for excessive messiness at the rate billed by our cleaning team. Double check for personal items that may be left behind and notify us within 24 hours of your departure. We will happily return them to you and bill you from your Security Deposit for shipping/handling of items to be returned. Any/all unclaimed items will be donated to local thrift stores.

Unauthorized late Check-outs

- Late Check-out's, without advanced authorization, will be billed at the full daily rate of the Check-out date, plus the fee imposed by our cleaning service starting at minimum \$75.00+. Please plan your time accordingly.

Noise & Quiet Hours

- Please be mindful and keep gatherings small and respectfful. To ensure a peaceful environment for everyone. If socializing outdoors, please keep voices low as they do carry and to avoid disturbing the neighbors. Per our HOA rules, you could be cited and fined/evicted for excessive noise at ANY time of day by the Sunriver Police Department.
- Please note: Our home resides in a noise-sensitive area and we participate in our Good Neighbor protection program. 

- **Driving Speed:** Our maximum driving speed is 25 mph, or as posted.
- **Parking:** Allowed only in a home driveway or a designated parking area.
- **Bicycles:** Bikes may be ridden only on established pathways, not on roadways or off-road.
- **Hot tubs:** Respect your neighbors' and the tranquility of Sunriver at all times and while using the hot tub. Quiet time begins at 10 pm-7 am and rules are enforced as necessary.
- **RV's and Trailers:** Because recreation vehicles/boats are not allowed to be parked in driveways or on roads, rental space in the Sunriver RV parking lot must be obtained from the Sunriver Owner's Association. Please call (541) 593-2411 during regular business hours for prior arrangements.
- **No littering:** Please help us keep Sunriver litter-free. Cleanliness counts!
- **Sunriver Recycling:** We now have home recycling. Please use the bins outside the garage and follow all guidelines.
- **Sunriver Critters:** Please take lots of photos, BUT, refrain from feeding or trying to handle the wildlife. Our non-human residents enjoy Sunriver as much as we do. Please be patient with the occasional deer, field mouse, squirrel, chipmunk or insect that might find their way onto the property. Sunriver is abundant with wildlife...enjoy viewing the extensive variety of birds and animals.
- **Barbecues:** Fire is our greatest danger! Only our gas BBQ is permitted and should be placed on the deck or paved driveway away from trees or ground cover. No wood fires or charcoal are permitted. Only electric/pellet/gas smokers are allowed.
- **No Fireworks!:** All fireworks, including safe & sane, are prohibited.

We hope you had a great stay! A few reminders before you go...

Please vacate the property before 11:00 without prior arrangement.

Basic Courtesy: *If you open it, close it. If you borrow it, return it. If you turn it on, turn it off. If you move it, put it back. Simple, yes?*

- **Start Dishwasher**-Clean the kitchen and all dishes. Load and start the dishwasher. Take ALL of your food/items with you.
- **Start washer load of bath towels**-Start one washer load of bath towels on the hot setting. Leave all other towels on the bathroom floors.
- **Don't strip the beds**-Our housekeepers will take care of this.
- **Trash and Recycling**-Take out all trash to the enclosure located out the man door in the garage. (Please do not leave in the garage). Make sure the **lids are snug** and the enclosure door is firmly closed. **Do not take bins to the road.** Follow all guidelines-when in doubt, place items in the trash. We pass on the charge of \$65.00/can for excess garbage and not following recycling guidelines.
- **Move furniture back**-If you have rearranged any furniture or items, please move them back to the original location. We pass on the fee of \$65.00 charge for moved furniture.
- **Leave the property the way you found it.** Clean up any spills, pick up litter. We charge for extra messiness.
- **Turn off lights**-turn off all lights & appliances.
- **Set thermostat**-Colder months, set thermostat to 62F on the Heat setting; Summer months, please set thermostat to 72F on Cool setting.
- **Hot tub off & secure**-Make sure the hot tub jets and air are turned off, the hot tub is covered, locked and the gate is closed (and latched). Place the key back on the kitchen counter.
- **Take last look for left behind items**-When you have finished loading your vehicle, go back through the property to double check that you have all your personal belongings. Check under beds, in closets and drawers, behind furniture (including dressers). The property owners, and/or cleaners, are **NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR MISSING ITEMS**. Shipping & handling of any items will be deducted from your security deposit. Please notify us within 24 hours of departure or items will be donated or disposed of.
- **Lock up**-Lock all doors & windows; pull down all shades on final departure.

Hot Tub Instructions

The hot tub padlock key is located on the kitchen counter, next to the door to the back deck. (Please make sure to return the key to this exact location). Instructions and safety info are provided. Hot tub towels are located on the shelves above the washer/dryer. (Please do not use bath towels for the hot tub-thank you!).

- Respect your neighbors and the tranquility of Sunriver at all times while using the hot tub. Noise and voices carry across to other properties. Quiet time is 10 pm-7 am. HOA rules/fines are enforced as necessary.
- Please observe all notices posted near the hot tub. The hot tub is professionally maintained by a hot tub servicing company. If you have any questions, please call the hot tub servicing company directly. You will find the contact information for the company who maintains the hot tub on the instruction sheet.
- If upon your arrival, you find that the hot tub is luke warm, please be patient and let it heat to the proper temperature. The hot tub is serviced and re-filled prior to your arrival. It may take 4-6 hours for the tub water to reach the desired temperature.







Using the Blu-ray players

In the Living room:





1. Check the label on the bottom of the remote to verify it is in the correct room.



There are 10 plastic cards on lanyards hanging from hooks in the entryway for you to use. Please bring towels (hot tub towels, not bath towels) as they do not provide them.

These cards give you access to the SHARC facility, tennis & pickleball courts and the Sunriver Owners' exclusive marina parking lot for launching on the Deschutes River. They do not cover rentals of any equipment or river shuttles. Please make individual arrangements for these other items or services. Guests do not have access to the Owners Fitness Room.

Be Aware: We charge \$300.00/each !!! to replace lost, stolen or misplaced card(s). It is your responsibility to

take great care of each card and to put them back on their respective hooks so that the next folks can enjoy them too. Thank you!



What is this card?

RECREATION PLUS CARD
The owner of your vacation rental has provided Recreation Plus cards for select access to Sunriver Owners Association (SROA) owned recreation amenities.

NOTE: These cards do NOT provide access to SHARC's fitness center or the Member Pool.

Recreation Plus cards provide access to:

- SHARC
- Disc Golf
- Tennis/Pickleball Courts
- SROA Boat Launch

How many access cards should there be?
There should be 2 cards for each bedroom, plus 2 extra cards.
For example: 4 bedrooms x 2 = 8 + 2 = 10 cards
If you have fewer cards than you were expecting, contact the owner or property manager.

Please return all cards to the vacation rental unit or to the property manager at check out to avoid a lost card replacement fee.

One card per person required for all entrants at SHARC, check-in (including spectators and non-swimmers). Ages 3 or younger are free.

Indoor pool open year-round; outdoor pools Memorial Day-Labor Day

- Cards can only be used once per day.
- Lap swim. Visit website for details.
- Must be 42" to ride body slide and 48" to ride tube slide.
- Children age 6 or younger must be accompanied in the pool by a guardian (age 16+) within reach at all times.
- Children age 11 or younger must be accompanied and supervised by a guardian (age 16+) at all times.
- Diapered children must wear a reusable swim pant over their diaper while in the pools (available for purchase).
- BRING A TOWEL. No towel service.
- Locker rooms available.
- Proper swim attire required.
- No outside food or beverage when cafe is in operation. You are welcome to have lunch at Paulina Park near the SHARC amphitheater.
- No GLASS containers in facility. Water bottle filling stations available.
- Revering/holding tubes, lounge chairs and shade umbrellas prohibited. See website about bringing your own shade.

Fireplace with gas assist

How to use the gas assist fireplace

CAUTION-(NOT FOR CHILDREN!!!)

Our real wood fireplace is easy to use. It has a gas assist/starting feature and does not require the use of paper/kindling (optional). The gas key and lighter are found in the basket on the mantle. The key inserts into the valve on the wall in the hall to the Left of the fireplace. Insert the key, have the lighter mechanism ready (with the glass doors completely open). Turn the key to start the gas and light the fire from the pipe under the wood grate.



IMPORTANT for SAFETY:

Once the wood is burning sufficiently, turn the gas off with the key and put it back in the basket on the mantle. It is VERY important that the gas is not left running once the fire is lit, AND the key is not left in the valve socket. This will prevent excess gas from accidentally being turned on and filling the house with natural gas! Always leave the glass doors open with fire going.

PLEASE do NOT start a fire on the morning of your departure. Leaving burning material in an unoccupied home is extremely dangerous. Thank you!
