Front Door Access & Locking Instructions

Our property uses a smart lock on the front door — no physical keys are needed.

Entering the Home

- Your 4-digit access code was sent in your check-in message.
- To unlock:
 1. Press the logo to wake up the keypad.
 2. Enter your 4-digit code.
 3. The lock will click open and the light will flash green.

?? Locking the Door at Checkout

- Make sure the door is fully closed.
- Press the house symbol with an X once to lock it — you'll hear the bolt engage.

? Pro Tips:

- If the keypad doesn't light up, press the logo to activate it.

- If it flashes red or won't lock, try re-entering the code to reset it.

If you have any issues with the lock, don't hesitate to reach out!

The Neighbourhood

Our home is tucked away in a quiet, peaceful country setting — the perfect place to relax and enjoy nature. You'll often hear birdsong, see wide open skies, and may even spot deer passing through the property. A hummingbird also visits regularly — keep an eye out near the flowers!

We hope you enjoy the pool and spa! To keep things safe and relaxing for everyone, please review the following:

? Pool Details

- **Depth:** 3 ft (shallow end) to 8 ft (deep end)
- **No Diving** – shallow areas can be dangerous

? Hours

- Open daily: 8:00 AM – 11:00 PM

? Supervision & Safety

- No lifeguard on duty – swim at your own risk
- Children must be supervised at all times

? Pool Cover

- **Code:** 1234, then press the arrow button
- Hold the button until the cover is fully opened or closed
- Keypad is located to the left of the pool heater
- Always cover the pool and hot tub when not in use. This will help to keep them heated, clean and the chemicals working properly.

? Spa / Hot Tub Guidelines

- A floating chlorine dispenser helps keep the water clean — please leave it in the hot tub at all times.
- The hot tub should stay running continuously, but feel free to turn the jets on during use and switch them off afterward.
- If you see an OH5 error, it means the hot tub has temporarily overheated. This can happen if it's been sitting unused. Simply leave the cover partially open and check back in about 20 minutes — it should reset on its own.
- Please don't adjust the temperature or other settings. If you have any concerns, we're always happy to help — just reach out!

? Please Do:

- Dry off before going indoors
- Use plastic cups or cans only
- Let us know right away if something isn't working — we're happy to help!

? Please Don't:

- No glass or food in or near the pool/hot tub
- No running, roughhousing, or smoking near the water
- Do not use the pool or spa if you are under the influence.

- Only the number of guests included in your booking are permitted on the property. Extra guests, tents, or campervans are not allowed. If additional guests are found to have stayed without prior approval, you will be charged for their stay along with a \$200 recovery fee.

How to use...

Outdoor Equipment

Grill

? Outdoor Cooking & Fire Guide

? Gas Grill (Propane Provided)

Great for grilling up burgers, veggies, or whatever you're craving.

To Use:

1. Make sure the propane tank valve is **fully open** (turn counterclockwise).
2. Open the grill lid before lighting.
3. Turn one of the burner knobs to "ignite" or "start" position.
4. Press the **igniter button** until you hear the burners light. You should see/hear the flame.
5. Once lit, adjust heat as needed and cook with the lid open or closed.

After Use:

- Turn off all burner knobs.
- Close the propane tank valve (clockwise).
- Give the grill a quick wipe-down if needed.

Safety Tips:

- Never use the grill with the lid closed during ignition.
- Always supervise while in use.
- Allow to cool fully before covering.

Mobile Fire Pit

? Mobile Fire Pit

Enjoy an evening fire—but please follow a few safety rules.

Important Location Note:

Due to many trees on the property, the fire pit is **best used on the driveway** to avoid fire hazards.

To Use:

1. Place the fire pit on a flat, non-flammable surface like the driveway.
2. Use **dry firewood only** (no trash or treated wood).
3. Keep flames low and manageable.
4. Always supervise children and never leave the fire unattended.
5. There are roasting sticks available in the entry closet of the house. Please clean these when finished using them.

Firewood:

Can be purchased locally, including at **Kwik Trip on Broadway** just 10 minutes away.

After Use:

- Make sure the fire is **completely out** before leaving it unattended.
- Do not dump ashes on the property.

Reminder: Please be respectful of neighbors and property safety—no fires during high winds or drought conditions.

Pool Use

? Pool Cover Instructions

- **Code:** 1234, then press the arrow button
- **Hold the button** (open or close) until the cover is fully moved.
- **Keypad Location:** To the left of the pool heater
- Always re-cover the pool when not in use to keep it clean and safe.

? Pool Maintenance Tools

- **Pool Noodles & Floating Seats:** Available in the shed for your enjoyment.
- **Skimmer Net:** Located nearby — feel free to use it to clear leaves or debris from the water surface.
- **Sump Pump for Rain:**
 - Stored next to the pool equipment.
 - When rain is expected, close the pool cover and place the pump in the center of the pool cover.
 - The attached hose should drain to the yard behind the pool.
 - This helps prevent the cover from becoming weighed down by rainwater.

Note: Please do not touch the pool mechanical equipment. If you notice any issues with water quality, heating, or function, feel free to reach out — we're happy to assist!

TV

? How to Use the Roku TV

Using the Roku TV is easy and intuitive. Here's a quick guide to get you started:

? Turning the TV On

- Use the **Roku remote** to press the **power button** (top center).
- If the TV doesn't respond, make sure it's plugged in and the remote has batteries.

? Roku Home Menu

- Press the **Home button** (?) on the remote to return to the main menu at any time.

? Watching TV or Streaming

- Use the arrow buttons to highlight a streaming app (like **Netflix**, **Hulu**, **Disney+**, **YouTube**, etc.).
- Press **OK** to open the app.
- Sign in with your own account if needed. Don't forget to log out before checkout!

? Switching Inputs (if needed)

- Press the **Home button**, scroll to **Settings > TV Inputs** to change to HDMI or other connected devices.

? Volume & Mute

- Use the **side volume buttons** on the Roku remote to adjust sound.
- The **Mute** button is located just below the volume buttons.

- If you logged into any apps with a personal account, please sign out before you leave.

If you're having trouble, try the following:

- **No Power?**
 - Make sure the TV is plugged in and the outlet has power.
 - Try pressing the **power button** on the TV itself (usually along the bottom edge).
- **Remote Not Working?**
 - Check or replace the batteries.
 - Make sure nothing is blocking the signal between the remote and the TV.
- **TV Won't Connect to Wi-Fi?**
 - Go to **Settings > Network > Check Connection**.
 - Restart the TV if needed by unplugging it for 10 seconds.
- **App Crashing or Freezing?**
 - Try exiting the app and reopening.
 - If that doesn't help, restart the TV by unplugging it, waiting 10 seconds, and plugging it back in.
- **Still having trouble?**

Electric Kettle and Keurig Coffee Maker

? Coffee & Tea Station Guide

? Electric Kettle (Amazon Basics)

Perfect for tea, instant coffee, or oatmeal!

To Use:

1. Fill the kettle with water (do not overfill past the max line).
2. Place it on the base and make sure it's seated properly.
3. Flip the switch down to turn it on — the light will come on.
4. It will automatically shut off once the water boils.
5. Carefully lift the kettle and pour slowly.

Important:

- Do **not** turn on when empty.
- Keep the kettle and cord away from the sink or wet areas.

? Keurig Mini Coffee Maker

A quick way to brew a single cup of coffee.

To Use:

1. Plug in the machine.
2. Open the top and insert a **K-Cup pod**.
3. Fill the water reservoir with **fresh water** (use your mug to measure).
4. Close the lid and place your mug on the tray.
5. Press the **brew button** (it will light up).
6. Wait while it heats and brews—your coffee will be ready in a minute or two!

Troubleshooting:

- If it doesn't start brewing, check that the lid is firmly closed and that the reservoir has enough water.
- If the machine doesn't turn on, check the outlet and ensure it's fully plugged in.

Stove

? Stove & Double Oven Guide

Your kitchen is equipped with an electric stovetop and a convenient double oven—perfect for cooking multiple dishes at once!

? Using the Stove (Cooktop)

- Turn the corresponding knob to control each burner.
- Adjust the heat level from low to high as needed.
- Indicator lights will show when a burner is hot—be careful, as it may remain hot even after being turned off.

? Using the Double Oven

- The top and bottom ovens can be used separately or at the same time.
- Each oven has its own temperature control knob.
- Preheat the oven to your desired temperature before baking or roasting.
- Use the top oven for smaller dishes or quick cooking, and the bottom oven for larger items or longer cooking times.

? Cleaning & Care

- Please wipe up any spills after cooking once surfaces have cooled.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or steel wool—use a soft cloth or sponge.
- If a spill happens in the oven, let us know if it needs attention.

?? Safety Tips

- Do not leave food unattended while using the stove or oven.
- Keep items like towels, paper, and plastic away from the burners.
- Always make sure all knobs are turned off after cooking.

- Use oven mitts—even the racks can stay hot for a while after use.

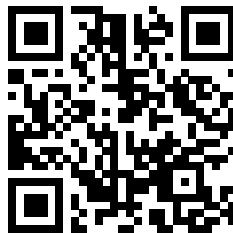

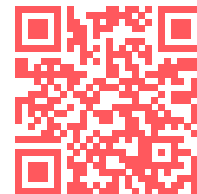
