Getting into the apartment - step by step:

1. Street gate

On the intercom, enter the street gate code:

2. Staircase

Turn right and walk up to the **2nd floor**
(3rd floor for overseas guests)

Please note that there is **no elevator**.

3. Lockbox location

On the 2nd floor, look to your right - you will find our **black digital lockbox** mounted on the wall.

4. Opening the lockbox

- Press **0** to activate the keypad
- Once the lights turn on, enter the code:

This information will be provided to you on the morning of your arrival day.

The lockbox will open automatically.

Please take the first set of keys.

A second set is waiting on the dining table inside the apartment.

The lockbox closes automatically after a few seconds - simply close the door.

The code remains valid until your checkout time.

5. Keys

You will find **three keys** on the keychain:

- Blue - street gate (optional, as the code also works)
 - White - corridor door (currently not in use)
 - Yellow - apartment door

6. Apartment door

After entering the corridor, **turn right**.

The white door marked **5A (with a green label)** is directly opposite you.

(The alarm system is not armed.)

7. Opening:

Turn the key to the left, press the handle down firmly, and open.



Drinking Water

Tap Water

The tap water in the apartment (and throughout Hungary) is **100% safe to drink** and meets strict European Union quality standards.

It comes directly from protected natural water sources and is regularly tested. Many locals drink tap water daily. Feel free to drink it, make coffee or tea with it, and refill your bottles before heading out. ?

Kitchen Equipment



Dishwasher

Using the dishwasher is very simple.

- 3 dishwasher tablets are provided for the start of your stay, in the **green box** next to the machine.
- Place **one tablet** into the flip-box container inside the dishwasher door.
- Press the **power** button.
- Select a program using the **program button** (under "ECO").
- **ECO** = longer, energy-efficient wash
- **Quick Plus 65** = short, everyday use cycle
- Close the door — the program will start automatically.
- At the end of the cycle, the door will **open automatically**.

Fridge / Freezer

The temperature is already set to the ideal levels, so no adjustment is needed.

If you notice the fridge not cooling properly, please let me know, and I will assist immediately.

Heating



Heating

The thermostat is located **on the living room wall, behind the TV.**

- Turn the middle knob to the **right to increase** the temperature.
- Turn the middle knob to the **left to decrease** the temperature.
- Default setting: **20°C**

For energy efficiency, please return the thermostat to **20°C** when leaving the apartment. Thank you!

Heaters in the apartment

The apartment has **four radiators**:

- 1 in the bedroom
- 2 in the living room
- 1 in the bathroom

Please note:

- The **towel-radiator in the bathroom works only when the central heating is on.**
- There is also a **small electric bathroom heater**, which you can turn on manually when needed.

Air Condition



Air Conditioning

Both the living room and the bedroom have A/C, and both units use the **same remote controller**.

- Please keep **all windows and the exterior door closed** while using the A/C for best performance.
- Recommended temperature: **23–24°C** for comfortable cooling.
- For energy efficiency, please **turn off the A/C when leaving the apartment**. Thank you!

Laundry Appliances



Washer–Dryer (2-in-1 Unit)

A 2-in-1 washer–dryer is located in the bathroom for your convenience. Three detergent capsules are provided for your start — you'll find them in the laundry box above the machine.

How to use:

- Select your preferred program.
- Place **one detergent capsule** into the drum.
- Close the door securely.
- Press **Start**.

The machine will **automatically continue to dry** after the washing cycle — there is **no separate drying-only** program.

If you need help, a quick **instruction manual** is placed on top of the machine next to the detergent box.

Bath Towels



If you're planning to visit Budapest's famous thermal baths, **green bath towels** (and a **picnic blanket**) are provided for your convenience.

You'll find them **on the right side of the TV cabinet** — please feel free to use them anytime.
