House Rules - Please Review (continued)

Compliance Note: Gilmer County strictly enforces Short-Term Rental (STR) ordinances. Violations of the rules regarding noise, occupancy, and parking can result in fines for guests and potential eviction without refund.

1. Quiet Hours & Noise (Strictly Enforced)

- County Ordinance: Gilmer County mandates specific quiet hours where noise must be kept to a minimum to respect our neighbors.
 - o Sunday – Thursday: 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM
 - o Friday – Saturday: 11:00 PM – 8:00 AM
- No Excessive Noise: Loud music, shouting, or disruptive behavior that can be heard from neighboring properties is prohibited at all times.

2. Occupancy Limits

- Maximum Occupancy: 4 Guests.
- Strict Limit: This number is set by the Fire Marshal and Gilmer County based on our septic system capacity and square footage.
- Visitors: No unregistered guests are allowed overnight unless approved by the hosts. Day visitors are allowed, guests are responsible for any damages caused to the property by day visitors.

3. Parking

- Designated Areas Only: Guests must park in the driveway only.
- Prohibited: Do NOT park on the street. Do not block any shared easements or neighbor's driveways.
- Vehicle Limit: We can accommodate a maximum of 3 vehicles.

4. Trash & Wildlife Safety (Bear Country)

- Secure Trash: We are in a natural habitat with black bears, raccoons, and other wildlife. Never leave food or trash outside or in your vehicle.
- Disposal: All trash must be bagged and placed inside the bear-proof Rigid metal box located at the end of the driveway. The key for the box locks is attached to a chain hanging from the right side of the box.
- Secure It: Ensure the lid is closed and locks are pushed in (i.e. box is locked) when finished.

5. Fire Safety & Fireworks

- Fireworks/Firearms: The discharge of firearms and fireworks is strictly prohibited on the property by county ordinance.
- Outdoor Fire Pit: Use the fire pit only if no "Burn Ban" is in effect. Keep fires contained and small. Never leave a fire unattended. Completely extinguish with water before going inside and cover the firepit with the metal cover.

6. Indoor Wood-Burning Fireplace

- OPEN THE FLUE FIRST: Before lighting a match, you must ensure the flue (damper) is open to allow smoke to escape.
 - o How to operate: Pull the metal lever inside the top of the firebox toward you until it locks. Use a flashlight to see if the flue is open.
 - o Test: Light a small piece of paper first. If smoke draws up the chimney, you are good to go. If smoke enters the room, the flue is closed.
- Proper Fuel: Use only the dry, seasoned firewood the host keeps in the woodshed outside. There is a supplied wood-carry bag at the shed (beige colored). Additional wood can be purchased nearby at local businesses like South Ellijay Firewood (24/7 self-serve), Walmart, or Home Depot. Do not use scavenged wood from the forest in the indoor fireplace.
- o Do Not Burn: Trash, plastic, glossy paper, pine needles, or "green" (wet) wood. These cause dangerous creosote buildup and excessive smoke.
- Tending the Fire:
 - o Keep the metal mesh screen door closed at all times while the fire is burning to prevent popping embers from damaging the floor or other property.
 - o Do not overload the firebox; a small, hot fire is safer and cleaner than a large, smoldering one.
 - o NEVER leave the fire unattended.
- Extinguishing:

- o Separate the logs and let the fire die down naturally.
- o DO NOT use water to extinguish an indoor fire; this can crack the masonry and ruin the firebox.
- o Do not close the flue until the ashes are completely cold (usually 24 hours later) to prevent Carbon Monoxide buildup in the cabin.
- **• Damages & Liability:**
- o Guests are fully responsible for any damage caused by negligent fireplace use. This includes but is not limited to: smoke damage to furniture/drapes from a closed flue, burn marks on flooring/rugs from escaping embers, or damage to the masonry from using water.

7. Septic System Care

- **Flush Rules:** This cabin operates on a sensitive septic system.
- **Do Not Flush:** Paper towels, feminine hygiene products, wipes (even "flushable" ones), or grease.
- **Toilet Paper Only:** Please flush only toilet paper and human waste. Damages/clogs caused by foreign objects will be charged to the guest.

8. Check-Out Procedures

- **Time:** Check-out is strictly at 10:00 AM to allow our cleaners time to prepare for the next guests.
- **Tasks:**
 - o Load and start the dishwasher.
 - o Bag and remove all trash from the property and place in the metal Rigid box upon departure (see #4 above).
 - o Place all towels in the tub.
 - o Lock all doors and windows upon departure.
 - o Drive safe on your way out!

Failure to comply with County Ordinances (Noise, Parking, Occupancy, Trash) may result in fines issued by Gilmer County Code Enforcement. The booking guest is responsible for any fines incurred during the stay.

- To ensure a peaceful environment for everyone, quiet hours are set by Gilmer County and can be reviewed under House Rules. If socializing outdoors, please keep voices low and other noise to a respectable minimum. If noise levels become disruptive, we kindly ask that you move inside to avoid disturbing our great neighbors.

Our cabin is surrounded by nature, so you may encounter birds, butterflies, squirrels, deer, insects, or even the occasional bear. We provide regular pest control, but wildlife encounters are part of mountain life. Encounters are possible and are at your own risk; we are not liable for wildlife activity during your stay.

- Only the number of guests included in your booking are permitted on the property. Extra overnight guests beyond the reservation are not allowed. If additional guests are found to have stayed without prior approval, you will be charged for their stay at a rate of \$150.

- This property has a strict **no parties** policy. Please be mindful and keep gatherings small and respectful. Noise travels in the mountains and we like to maintain a great relationship with our neighbors nearby.

Porch + Deck Lights

There are two, small plastic clickers on the front porch that work the string lights on the property. The one located next to the front door works the lights on the porch. Press the "On" button in the first row to turn these on. Similarly, to turn these off, press the "Off" button on the same row.

This same procedure works for the clicker next to the porch door. That clicker works the lights on the lower deck.



Turning on the TV

- Upon checkout, all credentials are erased and you are logged out of any accessed apps/accounts on the TV.






Outdoor Breeo Fire Pit

**IMPORTANT RULES:**

- Everyone is responsible for fire safety for themselves and for others.
- The Breeo is made of steel and gets very hot to the touch. Use caution when around the fire pit to avoid burns or injury.
- Do not extinguish the fire by saturating with water or by covering the fire pit with the lid. Both actions will damage the property and can result in damage fees assessed by the host.
- Be fire safe and observe all burn bans in effect during your stay for Gilmer County.

Kitchen Appliances**Stove**

If the stove isn't working, try holding down the LOCK button for 3–5 seconds to disable the safety lock.

If it still doesn't turn on, ensure you've placed a pot or pan on the element—our stove uses induction technology, which requires a compatible cookware item to activate. (all of our cookware is induction compatible)

Some nearby suggestions:


