



Split Airport (SPU)

? Option 1: Taxi (Fastest & Most Direct Option)

? Time: ~30-40 minutes

? Cost: €60-70 (official taxis) / **€40-50 for our private transfer**

? How to Take a Taxi:

? Exit the airport terminal and head to the **taxi stand** outside the arrivals area.

? Tell the driver to take you to **Osje?ka ulica 24C** in Split.

? Important: Always ask for an estimated fare before starting your journey to avoid unexpected charges—some drivers can be unreliable.

? Private Transfer Service:

Heating & Cooling

A/C Usage

Our apartment has **1 air conditioning unit**, providing both **cooling and heating** for your comfort. Here's how to use them efficiently:

? Maximizing Efficiency

? **Keep windows & doors closed** while the AC is running for best performance.

? **Ideal temperature:** Set to **22°C (72°F)** for a comfortable indoor climate.

?? Important Notes

? The **AC is pre-set** to an optimal setting upon arrival—please avoid unnecessary adjustments.

? In **hot summer months**, keep the AC on while you're out to prevent excessive heat buildup.

? **Never set below 20°C (68°F)**—extreme temperature differences can cause condensation and leaks.

Wi-Fi

Wifi Router Troubleshooting

? If you're having trouble with the WiFi, please check out my video showing what to do.

? The bigger black router is next to the TV. On the back, you'll see a black cable—just **unplug it**, wait **30 seconds**, then plug it back in.

? Wait a few minutes for the system to power back up—this usually fixes the issue.

? If it still doesn't work, just message me and I'll help right away!

TV

Using the TV

Our TV setup includes **two remotes**:

1?? **TV Remote LG** – Use to power the TV on and off

2?? **Cable Remote A1** – Controls cable channels.



How to Watch TV

- **Turn on both remotes** (TV and cable box).
- Under the TV, you'll find a small black device emitting programs; it must glow green to function
- Use the **cable remote** to browse and watch TV channels.

TV Troubleshooting

If the cable TV isn't working, here's what you can do to fix it quickly:

1. **Check the Remote & TV** – Make sure the TV is turned on and set to the correct input/source (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2). Try switching channels to see if it's just one channel affected.
2. **Check the Remote Batteries**
3. **Restart the TV Box** – Unplug the cable TV box from power, wait about **30 seconds**, and then plug it back in. Let it reboot—it may take a minute or two. (Please watch my video Guide how to)
4. **Check the Cables** – Ensure all cables are securely plugged in at the back of the TV and the cable box.
5. **Still Not Working?** – Please Let us know!

Appliance Guide & Usage Tips

Washing Machine

? Preparation

Before loading clothes, check for sand, paper, or debris to avoid drainage issues. (*This applies to all drains in the apartment!*)

? Detergent & Softener

- Open the detergent drawer.
- Use **compartment 2** for detergent.
- Add fabric softener in the **left corner (grey)**

? Program Selection

- Press On/Off Button
Turn the dial to preferred wash program.

? Start the Wash

Press **Start/Pause** to begin the cycle.

? Drying Options

For air-drying, use the **hanging racks**

The Dishwasher

? Dishwasher Tabs:

- Tabs are located **under the sink**.

? How to Start the Dishwasher:

1. **Place the tab** in the detergent compartment
2. **Press the ON/OFF button** to turn the dishwasher on.
3. **Choose the Program**
4. **Close the door**, it will start to work automatically

The Cooking Top

? Powering On/Off

Press and hold the power button for a few seconds.

? Selecting a Hot Plate

Press the button for the hot plate you want to use.

? Adjusting Heat Intensity

Use the **+-** buttons to increase or decrease the heat level as needed.

? Unattended Plate Alert

- If you hear beeping, check for any objects (like clothes) left on the surface. Keep the area clear to avoid unnecessary alerts.

The Oven

?? Set the Temperature

Turn the **first ring** to the left to select your desired temperature.

? Activate the Oven

Rotate the **second ring** to the right to turn on the oven. Choose a setting with either **two black horizontal lines** or the **cooling fan eco symbol** for optimal cooking.

Drip Coffee Maker

Need that caffeine fix? Here's how to brew a fresh pot with the drip coffee maker:

1. **Add water** – open the back lid and pour water into the tank (use the carafe for easy measuring).
2. **Pop in a filter** – you'll find paper filters in the kitchen
3. **Add ground coffee** – 1 to 2 tablespoons per cup, depending on how strong you like it.
4. **Close the lid** and press the **power button** – it'll start brewing right away!

In just a few minutes, your coffee will be ready and the apartment will smell amazing. ?

? No Hot Water? Here's the Fix!

Like most Croatian homes, we use a **water heater with a limited capacity**, controlled by a **wall switch**. Here's how to keep the hot water flowing:

- ? **Keep the Heater ON** – The main switch should **always stay on** for continuous hot water. (shown on the photo)
- ? **Capacity Limits** – Hot water may run out after **multiple long showers in a row**. If it happens, just **wait about an hour** for it to heat up again.

? **Still no hot water?** Contact us—we'll sort it out ASAP! ?

?Power Outage? No Worries!

First things first—**don't panic!** Power outages are rare, but if they happen, here's what to do:

- ? **Check the power switches** – If any have tripped, simply flip them back up. (switches location shown in photo)
- ? **Still no power?** Call me immediately, and I'll sort it out! ?

Trash disposal

Where to dispose of garbage and recyclables

Here's how to take care of your trash and recycling during your stay:

1. **Find the Spot:** Check out the map provided here. You'll see a marked spot with a '**Garbage**' pin—that's where you'll find the disposal bins.

Croatia follows a color-coded system for waste disposal:

- ? **Green Bin** – Glass bottles and jars
- ? **Blue Bin** – Paper, cardboard, magazines
- ? **Yellow Bin** – Plastic & metal (bottles, cans, packaging)
- ? **Brown Bin** – Organic waste (food scraps, biodegradable waste)
- ? **Black/Grey Bin** – Mixed waste (general trash that doesn't fit other categories)
